Ivy Installation Instructions

- Determine how much surface area needed to be covered.
- Order 3-5% extra ivy as you will have scrap during the installation process.
- The ivy comes in 20" x 20" or 24" x 24" squares depending on the type.
- Ivy is dye lot sensitive, if you reorder ivy for an existing area make sure to ask for the same dye lot as the original order.
- Use scissors or a carpet knife to trim the ivy to fit the surface area as needed.

Chain Link Fence:

- Use green or black zip ties to attached the ivy every 4" around the perimeter and every 4" throughout the complete surface area of the ivy.
- Cut off excess zip tie overage.

SUPERHEDGE ARTIFICIAL IVY

Wood Fence:

- Use wood screws and a washer to attach the ivy to the wood fence every 4" around the perimeter and every 4" throughout the complete surface area of the ivy.
- Make sure to not use wood screws longer than the thickness of the wood fence.

Concrete, Cinder Block or Stucco:

- Use a hammer drill to drill a hole for the screw using a carbide or titanium drill bit.
- Use a screw designed for concrete, cinder block or stucco.
- Put a washer on the screw to hold the ivy against the surface every 4" around the perimeter and every 4" throughout the complete surface area of the ivy.

Ivy Maintenance

- Hose or wipe ivy with water to clean as needed.
- Use soap or detergent to clean stubborn dirt or stains.
- Use paint thinner as needed for graffiti.
- Use CLR cleaner if ivy has white calcium stains from water over spray
